



  - Face to face students will test during the class period
  - Virtual students will test at home
  - Dates TBA by your student's teachers (check <u>Canvas</u> calendars)
  - •The Math and Reading Assessments are two parts, and may take up to two days
- **Assessments** These assessments benchmark student progress at key points in the year.
  - •These assessments must be done on a laptop or desktop computer <u>phones or iPads</u> <u>cannot be used</u>.
  - •Students will access the TEA Interim Assessment App through Classlink.


#### Progress Monitoring Assessments

- •Students will take LCISD Progress Monitoring Assessments (PMAs) throughout the year
  - Jan. 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Science & March 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> ELAR Revising & Editing
  - Face to face students will test during the class period
  - Virtual students will test at home through Eduphoria Aware Online found in <u>Classlink</u>
  - Dates TBA by your student's teachers (check <u>Canvas</u> calendars for each course)
  - These are best when completed in one sitting.
- PMAs will gauge student progress on standards covered by that point in the year.
- Must be done on a laptop, desktop computer, or iPad (no phones).
- •Students will access the Eduphoria Aware App through <u>Classlink</u>.
  - Log in is the same as Classlink without student initials
  - Ex. Classlink log in: ao123456 Eduphoria log in: 123456
  - The password is the same used for Classlink
