



TEA Interim Assessments

- Math, Reading, Science (8th only), and Social Studies (8th only) will be giving TEA Interim Assessments this spring starting in February.
 - Face to face students will test during the class period
 - Virtual students will test at home
 - Dates TBA by your student's teachers (check <u>Canvas</u> calendars)
 - The Math and Reading Assessments are two parts, and may take up to two days
- These assessments benchmark student progress at key points in the year.
- These assessments must be done on a laptop or desktop computer – phones or iPads cannot be used.
- Students will access the TEA Interim Assessment App through Classlink.
 - Log in information for each assessment can be found on <u>Skyward Family Access</u> using these <u>directions</u>.
 - Directions for accessing the Interim Assessment App in Classlink can be found <u>HERE</u> or in your teacher's <u>Canvas</u> course.
 - Algebra students will take the Algebra Interim Assessment
 - 7th Grade PAP Math Students will take the 8th Math Interim Assessment
