

- For the remainder of the week, the Leaman counselors will be in classes helping 8th grade students select their courses in their Career Plan for 9th grade. - The high school course selection window closes at 8 am on February 10, 2020. Please have all 9th grade courses selected in Skyward and a parent/guardian signature by this deadline.
- On March 2nd and 3rd, the CFHS counselors will meet with 8th graders 1-on-1 to review selected courses and make changes, if necessary.
- Parents will have to sign a form, indicating they agree with the final courses selected by the student and review by the high school counselors.
