HOW YOU CAN HELP YOUR STUDENT INCREASE RESPONSIBILITY

- 1. HOLD STUDENTS ACCOUNTABLE.
 GIVE CONSEQUENCES WHEN YOUR EXPECTATIONS ARE NOT MET.
- 2. START EARLY.
 GIVE CHILDREN SMALL, DAILY RESPONSIBILITIES/CHORES. FOR EXAMPLE, MAKE
 THEM SET AN ALARM TO LEARN THE IMPORTANCE OF WAKING UP BY
 THEMSELVES. YOU ARE TEACHING THEM THAT EVERYONE HAS INDIVIDUAL
 RESPONSIBILITIES, WHICH IS A VALUABLE LESSON FOR THE FUTURE.
- 3.SET THE EXAMPLE.
 MEET YOUR OWN RESPONSIBILITIES AND LABEL THEM FOR YOUR CHILDREN TO UNDERSTAND AND SEE THAT YOU HAVE AND FULFILL YOUR OWN RESPONSIBILITIES AS AN ADULT AND PARENT.
- 4. TEACH AND SHOW YOUR CHILD HOW TO BE ORGANIZED AND TO MANAGE TIME.
 CREATE A SCHEDULE FOR CHORES, HOMEWORK, MORNING AND EVENING ROUTINES. REMEMBER THAT A SUCCESSFUL MORNING STARTS THE NIGHT REFORE.
- 5. TEACH FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY.
 COME UP WITH A PLAN THAT ESTABLISHES RULES ABOUT ALLOWANCE AND WHAT
 THEY PAY FOR AND WHAT YOU PAY FOR.
- 6. TALK TO YOUR STUDENT ABOUT CHOICES, THE CONSEQUENCES OF CHOICES, AND ALLOW THEM TO MAKE SOME DECISIONS. THIS WILL TEACH THEM RESPONSIBILITY, WILL ALLOW THEM TO FEEL MORE SELF-CONFIDENT, AND WILL GIVE THEM PRACTICE FOR WHEN THEY ARE ADULTS.
- 7. COACH YOUR CHILD TO SOLVE THEIR OWN PROBLEMS.
 THIS ALLOWS THEM TO UNDERSTAND THE CONTROL THEY HAVE OVER THEIR DECISIONS AND THEIR CONSEQUENCES. IT HELPS THEM PRACTICE BECOMING THEIR OWN PROBLEM SOLVER.
