

starting.




CELL PHONES

SAFETY CONFLICT


If you are having an issue with another student, <u>let</u>

Fighting is a violation of the code of conduct.


Any student who fights will receive consequence in accordance with code of conduct.

Offenses are color coded based on the level of violation based on the Texas Penal Code and the possible charge.


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No Color – Class C Misdemeanor





TARDY PROCESS




Tardy Discipline System

<u>3</u> Tardies	Parent contact/behavior contract
7 Tardies	Office referral and AP will assign consequence
10 Tardies	Office referral and AP will assign consequence

- -When a student reaches 3 tardies, their parents will get an email and phone call notifying them of their student's actions. Those students will sign a behavior contract.
- -When a student reaches **7 tardies**, Skyward will generate an office referral. APs will assign a consequence as appropriate.
- -When a student reaches 10 tardies, Skyward will generate an office referral. APs will assign a consequence as appropriate.

^{*}Tardies reset every 6 weeks.
