

MORNING MATH

All third, fourth and fifth graders participate in Morning Math on Monday-Thursday of each week. Upon arriving at school, students get their MM worksheet and sit in the hall to complete it. When it is time to go into the classroom, students take their paper with them and have until 8:00 a.m. to finish the work. This paper is checked and corrected with their math teacher at the beginning of the math period as their warm-up.

Some students are assigned to a tutorial teacher for Morning Math. Students who are assigned to a tutorial teacher and eat breakfast at school have a 'Fast Pass' which lets them cut in the front of the breakfast line. They get their breakfast and take it to the tutorial room, eat breakfast, then complete the worksheet.

At the beginning of the year, third graders had Fast Focus lessons for MM. Fourth and fifth graders had Countdown to TAKS lessons. Currently, all three grades have Countdown to STAAR lessons. All of these lessons are a spiral of math skills in word problem format. Sample copies of these lessons are available on our website.
