
Selecting a Primary Care Physician with your NexusACO™ plan.

When you enroll you will be asked to select a PCP for each covered family member. To get started, visit welcometouhc.com/nexus2.


Choose from Primary or Specialty care, and then select the type of physician.




Select the "Search the network" link.









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A list of PCPs in your ZIP code area will be displayed. Choose a Tier 1 PCP for the highest level of coverage.
