
UPDATE: Attendance Boundary Committee Recommendations for Morgan and Huggins Elementary Schools

Lamar CISD's Morgan Elementary will open in January 2022. However, the school will function independently on the Huggins Elementary campus during the fall 2021 semester. An Attendance Boundary Committee (ABC)—made of community members from the areas under consideration for rezoning—will recommend the attendance zone for Morgan Elementary to the Lamar CISD Board of Trustees.

The ABC held a public input meeting Jan. 28 at Fulshear High School to listen to the thoughts and concerns of families living in the impacted areas. After that input, the ABC met for the third time on Feb. 1 and decided to take its recommendation to the Board of Trustees without making any boundary changes (see below). The ABC also recommends the School Board offer an "exception request" for 5th-grade students for the 2021-2022 school year.

The zoning recommendation is based on the latest demographic projections, facility capacity, enrollment, optimizing existing facilities and public input. The ABC also looked closely at current and projected growth trends, trying to alleviate overcrowding while minimizing the movement of students to new schools. If this recommendation is approved, the map below will become the official attendance boundaries of Morgan and Huggins elementary schools.

The committee will present its recommendation at the Feb. 18 Board of Trustees meeting. The meeting will begin at 7 p.m. and be held in the Board Room of the Brazos Crossing Administration Building, 3911 Avenue I, Rosenberg.
