

Public Input on Lamar CISD Attendance Boundary Committee Recommendations for Secondary (6-12) Attendance Zones

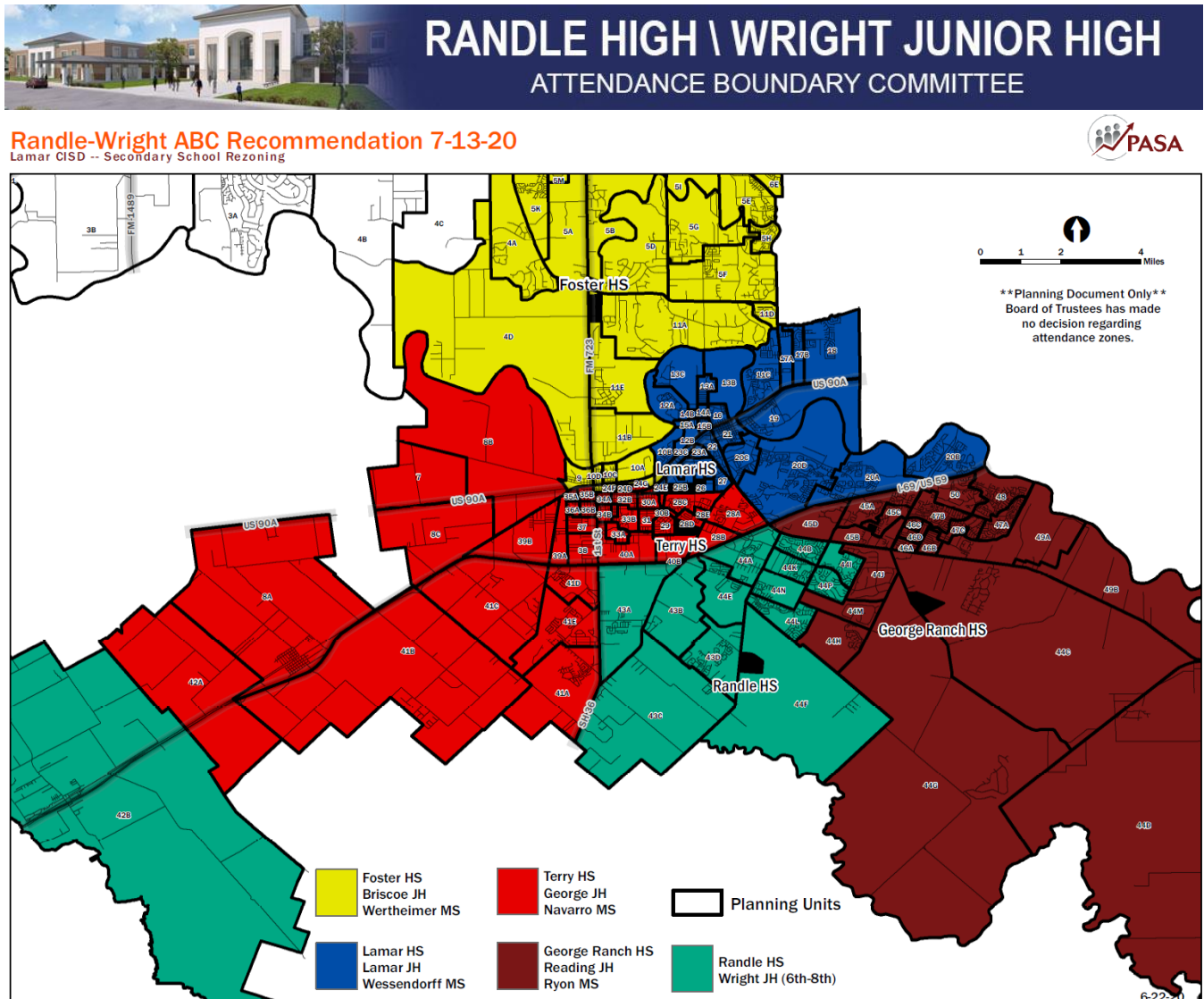
Randle High School and Wright Junior High School will open for the 2021-2022 school year. The Lamar CISD Attendance Boundary Committee (ABC)—made up of parents from across the District—will make its zoning recommendation to the Lamar CISD Board of Trustees for new attendance boundaries.

The ABC is seeking input from families living in the impacted areas before it makes its final recommendation to the Board of Trustees. A public input meeting will be held July 27 at 7 p.m. at George Ranch High School, located at 8181 FM 762 in Richmond.

The purpose of a public input meeting is for parents in the community to provide input to the ABC. Individuals interested in speaking to the committee will enter at the main high school entrance. Due to the Governor's Order, both social distancing and masks will be required. This could result in limited seating.

Your input will help the ABC finalize its recommendation to the Board of Trustees. The recommendation will be based on the latest demographic projections, facility capacity, student enrollment numbers and optimal utilization of existing facilities. The ABC also looked closely at the current and projected trends, trying to alleviate overcrowding, while minimizing the movement of students from existing zones.

The consensus of the committee was to move forward with the boundary recommendation shown below.
